E-2 Approve Contract Amendment to KPFF Inc. Professional Services Agreement #9051 for the Engineering Design & Permitting Services for the Demolition and Replacement of the Terminal 1 Dock Structure

Greg Westrand, Senior Project Manager presented the action item and discussed it with the commission.

On motion by Commissioner Burkman, seconded by Commissioner Orange and carried unanimously, the Board of Commissioners authorize the CEO to execute a contract amendment of \$765,442 with KPFF Inc., to perform engineering, design, and permitting services for the demolition and replacement of Terminal 1 dock structures for a total contract amount not-to-exceed \$4,030,327.
