PORT OF VANCOUVER USA BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING Tuesday, June 11, 2024

CALL TO ORDER

Commission President LaBrant called a regular meeting of the Port of Vancouver Board of Commissioners to order and open to the public at 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, June 11, 2024, at the Port of Vancouver USA Administrative Office, 3103 NW Lower River Road, Vancouver, Washington 98660.

SUBJECT:	Approve First Amendment to the Purchase and Sale Agreement for Tax Parcels 152804-000 and 986029-240		

BACKGROUND:

This action enhances the port's Strategic Plan goal to support a 20-year land use strategy involving port properties that help achieve long term port and community goals to create and retain jobs supporting the continued growth in the local economy.

The commission approved the purchase and sale Agreement (PSA) for the property in August 2023. Since that time, the port completed its due diligence of the property and worked with the property owner to address actions needed to close on the property. This amendment to the original PSA sets the final purchase price at \$15,600,000 and outlines the procedure the parties will take to transfer the in-water DNR leased area from the seller to the port. In anticipation of this property transaction, the Board of Commissioners approved and executed Resolution 3-2024 providing for the issuance and sale of limited tax general obligation bonds for the acquisition of real property which was complete on June 4, 2024.

Acquiring this property and active leasehold will 1) add approximately 33 acres to the port's maritime and heavy industrial land portfolio; 2) provide a lease income stream to significantly offset the purchase price; 3) contribute property for a rail corridor to support rail service to Columbia Gateway; 4) add a significant community partner to the port's tenant portfolio; and, 5) significantly improve future development opportunities for the adjacent port-owned property.

In addition to over 33 acres of land and existing maritime related jobs, this action will contribute over \$900,000 in annual lease revenue to the port – with a scheduled increase exceeding \$1,000,000 annually expected in 2026.

The cost for this purchase is in the approved 2024 budget. Closing is expected to occur in the third quarter of 2024.
