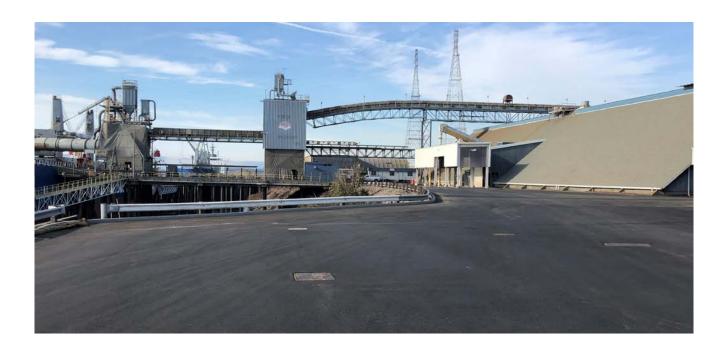


- Project 100% complete
