PORT OF VANCOUVER USA BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING Tuesday, November 12, 2024

CALL TO ORDER

Commission President LaBrant called a regular meeting of the Port of Vancouver Board of Commissioners to order and open to the public at 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, 2024, at the Port of Vancouver USA Administrative Office, 3103 NW Lower River Road, Vancouver, Washington 98660.

OPENING REMARKS

Commissioner LaBrant welcomed everyone to the commission meeting. He announced no executive session was held and that the meeting is being recorded. He stated this meeting is a hybrid meeting so that along with everyone present in the meeting, anyone who wants to make virtual oral comment can use Zoom. He then invited guests to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Regular Meeting of October 22, 2024

On motion by Commissioner Orange, seconded by Commissioner Burkman and carried unanimously, the Board of Commissioners approve the minutes of the October 22, 2024, regular meeting.

Community Fund Update - Ke Kukui Foundation and 4 Days of Aloha

CEO Julianna Marler welcomed Julie Rawls, the port's Community Relations Manager to the podium to introduce one of this year's port Community Fund Program recipients prior to their presentations.

Community Relations Manager Julie Rawls provided an overview of Ke Kukui Foundation and 4 Days of Aloha and welcomed Shay Kealoha and Io Eltagonde to share more about the festival.

Ke Kukui Foundation's Board President, Shay Kealoha and Board Member lo Eltagonde presented an overview of the Foundation's mission, and their efforts to make Hawaiian traditions accessible to the community. The Four Days of Aloha is an annual event which draws attendees nationwide and offers an immersive experience with Hawaiian cultural practices, traditional foods, arts, and crafts. Shay highlighted the festival's economic impact on the local community. The 2025 festival is scheduled for July 24-27. They closed by thanking the port for its support in making their program possible.

On motion by Commissioner Burkman, seconded by Commissioner Orange and carried unanimously, the Board of Commissioners authorize the CEO to sign the Second Amendment to Lease between the Port of Vancouver USA and Boise Cascade Building Materials Distribution, LLC.

<u>E-3 Approve the First Amendment to the Lease and Consent to Assignment Between</u> the Port of Vancouver USA and Metro Metals Tacoma, LLC
